Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

This MOU between Garrison, Wiskerchen & Coates, Ltd. (DBA Zephyr Wellness), hereafter referred to as “Zephyr” and Walk The Talk America, hereafter referred to as “WTTA,” addresses ongoing partnership between the two organizations for the purposes of fostering, promoting, and developing educational dialogue between the communities of mental health and firearm owners. Partners of Zephyr will be able to make changes to this MOU with a minimum of 30 days’ notice to WTTA unless immediate action is necessary due to noncompliance. WTTA may request alterations to this MOU with a minimum of 30 days’ notice given for implementation of changes. The latter can be shortened at the agreement of both parties in order to expedite implementation of changes.

Whereas, Zephyr embraces a mission to provide citizens in our community, state, and country with the best possible care for mind, body and spirit through accessible, holistic and compassionate approaches that honor personal freedom; and,

Whereas, Zephyr seeks partnerships to bring about the safest, most innovative and emergent clinical practices available with the highest cultural competence possible in order to achieve its mission; and,

Whereas, WTTA seeks to raise awareness and create a change in the misunderstandings regarding mental illness and firearms by bringing together industry leaders to reduce gun violence, negligence, suicide and the trauma created by these events; and,



Whereas, WTTA aims to eradicate the prejudice that both the firearms and mental health industries face while reducing the number of tragedies and deaths that have occurred over the years since the US has had a decline in mental health funding and education; and,

Whereas, programs to achieve the above stated missions and goals can be accomplished through such an MOU; now,

Therefore be it resolved that Zephyr and WTTA shall join in official partnership to share resources and information to advance the dialogue about gun ownership and mental health care to demystify and destigmatize both fields for the advancement of the safety and health of all Americans.

Any conflicts of interest or other issues that may impede service delivery to clients of either agency will be addressed as soon as reasonably possible between one of Zephyr’s executive partners and WTTA. At no time will this MOU be construed in any way to insinuate that client information or PHI will be shared between the organizations. The MOU shall be reviewed between parties after three months and annually thereafter.

This MOU is hereby agreed upon and entered into by Zephyr Wellness and Walk The Talk America.
